

# New Technology Opportunities at California R-I



- Citrix is a virtual computer that enables students to use programs that the school has purchased, including the latest versions of Microsoft Word and PowerPoint, anywhere they have internet access.
- Citrix provides password-protected storage for all student documents for use at school or home.
- Using Citrix only requires a computer, an internet connection (preferably DSL or faster), and the user id and password students create at school.

To access Citrix: Click on the **CITRIX** logo on the district home page (<http://www.californiak12.org>) and download the Client application.

By clicking the icon on the left from the district page, students and parents can also search the library collections of all three buildings anywhere they have internet access.

Using the online card catalog, students and parents can:

- Identify books that will be useful in projects and assignments and print a list for easy location at school.
- See book covers, summaries, and reviews of popular titles for reading and research.
- Retrieve publication information for bibliographies and works cited pages.
- Hold books for check out, post book reviews, and create multiple lists for leisure reading and assignments (requires log in created at school).
